

Corporate Finance Analyst

About the role:

The Corporate Finance Analyst will be responsible to provide financial analysis and support on strategic corporate initiatives and market analysis and presentations. This includes supporting acquisitions, bank and capital markets funding, competitor and market analysis.

With a head office based in Dubbo, NSW and with offices in other locations including Sydney, Orange, Tomago and Brisbane, the successful candidate will be based in either Homebush (Sydney), Brisbane or in Dubbo. Regular travel will be required to head office if you reside outside of Dubbo.

Duties include:

- Financial modelling: Build and maintain financial models to support strategic decisions considering earnings, liquidity and capital creation. Models developed to support scenarios and assumption sensitivities
- Competitor analysis: analyse competitors and market and regulatory trends to support the overall group strategy and assessment of acquisition targets
- Acquisitions: valuation and due diligence support
- Market presentations: preparation of external presentations and analysis to support the group's investor program
- FP&A: provide financial analysis and modelling support to the group's FP&A function
